On Display Hank Ruckert's Gourd Art Collection


I've been going to different crafts shows and farmers markets for over a decade. I guess you might say, "I'm hooked on gourds!"

- → A Fraud Alert on a transaction can be triggered for a number of different reasons.
- → The fraud dept. will send a text message first to the cell phone number on file. (see example left)
- → If no response after 15 minutes, a phone call will be made.
- → The phone call will begin, "This is the Fraud Prevention Department at Kaw Valley State bank calling for (customer name)".
- → They will NOT ask to verify debit card number or social security number.
- → They WILL verify the zip code tied to the debit card.
