



### **Watch Out for Scams!**

Beware of scammers! They go after *everyone*, no matter your age! They can be incredibly convincing, too. Below we've listed a few common scams and red flags. You can *always* call the bank if you have concerns or questions about possible fraud.

- Family Member in Trouble: They'll claim they are with your grandchild or other relative and say they're in trouble of some kind, usually jail. They'll say they need you to send them money ASAP. If you call the relative, however, they will know nothing about this "friend" who called you. Rule of thumb: don't answer phone calls from numbers you don't recognize or that aren't in your personal contacts. If its important, they'll leave a message and you can call them back.
- Lottery Winner: Everyone wants to win big, but scammers will tell you in order to get
  your money, you have to send them money first, usually claiming you need to pay taxes
  on it first. If you really won the lottery, you do not pay taxes up front.
- Gift Cards/Secret Shopper: Being asked to buy gift cards is always a huge red flag!
   They will tell you to purchase several gift cards from whatever place you are supposedly secretly shopping and then send them the card information in order to receive your payment. You are essentially giving them free money.
- Email/Text Links: Scammers send out emails with false links. They claim to be with a legitimate company and it can look pretty convincing. The links lead to false websites where they ask you to input your information to "verify". Links can also contain malware that infect your computer or cell phone with viruses and can "spy" on you when you enter login credentials for websites or other personal information. Do not open any unfamiliar emails or links. Make sure your antivirus software on your devices is up to date and working—you can even put antivirus software on your cell phone!
- Fake Checks: Some scammers operate by sending you a fake check in the mail and tell you to send money back to them. By the time the check bounces, you've already sent money back and are now out of that money. This can result in major negative balances in accounts that you're required to pay back. If you are unfamiliar or uncertain about the sender of the check, you can always talk to a bank employee about it. You can also ask for a hold to be put on the check until it clears so the money can't be spent. A check can take up to two weeks to come back as fraudulent, but usually comes back sooner.

If you are uncertain or suspicious about anything, feel free to reach out to KVSB employee!
