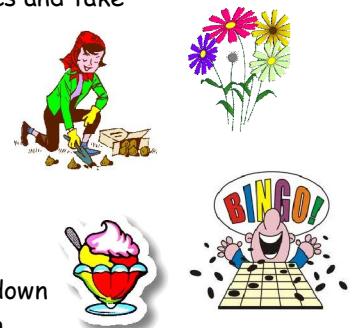
August 1st Annual Back to School Pancake Feed! - Wamego Senior Center - Serving at 9:00 AM

On Display: Tom Sterrett's Hot Wheels Collection!

In 1968, Well-known American toymaker Mattel introduced the Hot Wheels brand of die cast toy cars. They were the primary competitor of Match Box cars until 1997 when Mattel purchased Tyco Toys, owner of Match Box.

The first production line in 1968 consisted of the "Sweet Sixteen", one of which is the Deora, a 1965 Dodge A100 customized pickup. The purple Deora with surfboard in the display was one of my first Hot Wheels and with the exception of one missing surfboard, has withstood the last 50 + years in my possession. I didn't start collecting series of cars until the 2012 HW Racing Series, but prior to that I just bought casings I liked and hung them on the wall.

In 2017 they celebrated their 50th Anniversary of the Camaro with a dedicated series. The 50th Anniversary

Of Hot Wheels was in 2018 with several series noting the Anniversary. My Collection consists of roughly 500 casting, very small in comparison to others who have up to 10,000 and more cars.

All Locations will be closed in observance of Memorial Day.



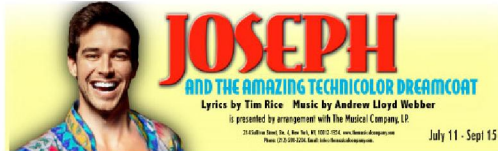
